## Artists of the Oaks Art Class Instructors Form

Artists of the Oaks wishes to promote life-long art learning opportunities primarily for members and also for the wider community by providing art instruction and exploration.

Members and/or non-members of AOTO may be art instructors. Participants in class must compromise no less than 80% LWW residents. An approved AOTO class must enroll three or more club members. Typically, a class session is expected to be 2 or 3 hours in duration. A prospective instructor may request a club subsidy of \$50. Classes may be held in the LWW Community Center, parks, or private homes and materials fees may be included in the class cost. The reservation for LWW facilities will be made through a AOTO member. Classes may be one session or a series of classes. The class instructor is expected to teach and demonstrate best artistic practices. Following the class session(s), a brief self-evaluation and participation list will be submitted by the instructor to the AOTO board.

At least a month in advance, class instructors must submit a written plan to the AOTO President to get on the Board agenda for approval. Please complete the attached form and submit to AOTO President.
